### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On March 19, 1939, pulled tubing, preparing to clean out cavings. On March 28, 1939, ran tubing with 4-1/2" x 2" EUE x 80" Rubber Robinson TP Packer set at 3476', tubing set at 3659'1".

Production prior to cleaning out: Averaged 15 bbls. oil, no water, for 16 days before work over; estimated gas 50,000 cu. ft.

Production after cleaning out: Flowed 14 bbls. oil, no water, 24 hours, thru open 3/4" choke; gas estimated at 125,000 cu. ft.
