6. Well was then jet perforated from 3494' to 3508' with 48 shots. Zone was treated with 500 gallons mud cleanout acid. Swabbing tests showed water with about 1% oil. Swabbed at rate of 40 barrels per hour and fluid stayed about 900 feet from surface.
7. Set Lane Wells cast iron bridge plug with top at 3490' with one sack quickset cement. Will produce zone from 3468-78 which is in top of Seven Rivers formation.
