Amerada Hess requests approval to simultaneously dedicate a previously established 320 acre Jalmat gas proration unit to the following wells:

State LMT #2 - 1980' FNL & 1980' FWL State LMT #5 - 660' FNL & 660' FEL

The marginal unit currently consists of the N/2 of Sec. 36, T-23S, R-27E, with all the acreage dedicated to the State LMT #2 as per Order NSP-744 issued February 10, 1966.

State LMT #5 is currently dual completed, as an active injector in the Langlie Mattix Pool, and as a temporarily abandoned producer in the Jalmat Pool. Prior to being abandoned in the Jalmat Pool, #5 was classified as a Jalmat Oil well. Due to a high GOR it was closed-in and temporarily abandoned on July 1, 1965.

Amerada Hess Corporation believes approval of this request will protect correlative rights, and encourage the efficient recovery of gas reserves.
