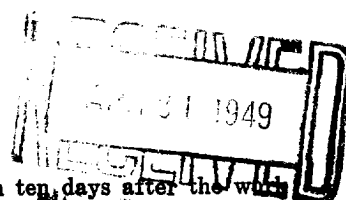

3485' Total Depth, Lime. Ran Temperature Survey & found top cement @ 2200'. Ratio of Actual to calculated fill 31.2%. Nippled up on 5 1/2" Csg. Went in hole w/4-3/4" bit, 10 jts. 2-7/8" Drill Pipe, & 100 jts. 2-3/8" OD. EUE, Tubing. Tested Casing with 1000# for 30 mins. was O.K. Drilled cement from 3417' to 3458' & tested casing with 900# was O.K. Started drilling formation at 6:30 P.M. 4-17-49.
