Loaded shot with 65 gals. 1/4" Pea Gravel. Top of gravel at 3490' Shot went off at 9:05 A.M. 6-10-49. Washed out shot hole with alternating Conventional & Reverse circulation. Rigged up and swabbed 12 hrs. Results unsatisfactory.
