17. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed work) SEE RULE 1403.

An attempt was made by Skelly Oil Company to clean out this well to total depth on June 16, 1976. Well was cleaned out from 2912' to 2930'. Formation and cement were recovered which indicated casing is probably parted at 2915'. Clean out attempt was shut down and Jalmat Yates zone was returned to production. On December 12, 1979, this well was shut-in and abandoned as to the Jalmat (Gas) pool so that the allowable for the E/2 SW/4 Section 36 could be assigned to Hartman Maralo State No. 1. Because this well is no longer productive we propose to plug and abandon it. We propose to set a cement retainer at 2400 feet and squeeze below this retainer with 300 sacks of cement or until we have squeeze pressure of 1500 psi. We will set a 25 sack cement plug from 1300 feet to 1075 feet, and a 50 sack cement plug from 500 feet to surface. The exact location of the well will be shown by a steel marker set in cement. This marker will be 4 inches in diameter and will extend 4 foot above ground level. The well name, well number, unit letter, section, township and range will be welded on the marker. Location will be leveled and cleared of all junk. After work is completed, District office of Division will be contacted to inspect plugged well and location.

INSTEAD OF CEMENT RETAINER AT 2400 CLEAN THE WELL OUT TO 2930 & SET 100' PLUG.
