### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 3600'. Ran 280 quarts of glycerine from 3485' to 3600'. Followed with 1/2 yard of gravel and 4 sacks of Cal Seal. Bomb set for 8:00 AM, May 15, 1947.

Well was cleaned out to total depth. Flowed well in tank 7 hours and started potential. Flowed well on 1" choke 12 hours on potential test. Made 18.38 barrels/day, 5% water, 1% BS, 1946 MCF gas per day.
