DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 200 qts of special oil well explosive No. 1 solidified nitro-glycerine in 3 1/2" WJ shells from 3610' to 3501' with AF Duplex 24 hour time bomb. American Glycerin Company, shooter. Bomb set for 24 hours. Bolshevik cave catcher, 3' of brick, and 5' of pea gravel placed on top of catcher. Dumped 10 sacks Calseal from 3493' to 3405' and stemmed with oil to surface. Shot exploded @ 9:46 a.m., May 19, 1949, and now cleaning out.
