DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

7" casing was set at 2911' with 1,500 sacks of 3% G_ol cement. Cement returned to 700' D.F. one 1/2" hole was perforated at 690' D.F. and 225 sacks of cement. was pumped through it. The cement circulated. Casing shut-off was tested on August 30 with 1,200# for 30 minutes and was found good.
