Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

This well was drilled to 3290' in lime. Ran 104½ joints (3281.30') of 5½" OD 14# 8R J-55 SS casing set at 3289' and cemented with 250 sacks containing 4% gel and 300 sacks of neat cement. Plug was down at 6:50 A.M., February 1, 1956. Cement was allowed to set 72 hours prior to testing for shut-off. 1000 pounds pressure was applied prior to drilling out and there was no drop in pressure. Shoe was not drilled.
