Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

This well was drilled to 1251' in anhydrite. Ran 38 joints, 1241.35', of 8 5/8" OD 28# SR H-40 SS casing set at 1251 and cemented with 575 sacks of cement with 45 gal and 200 sacks of neat cement on bottom. Cement circulated. Plug was down at 11:30 A. M., January 20, 1956. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours before testing for shut-off. Before drilling plug, 1000 pounds pressure was applied during a 30 minute interval with no drop in pressure. After drilling plug, 600 pounds pressure was applied during a 30 minute interval with no drop in pressure. Drilling resumed.
