Scott, hereby submit their application for the establishment of a non-standard gas proration unit of 320 contiguous acres surrounding their Daniel Vaughn B-3 #1 Well located in the Jalmat Gas Pool of Lea County, New Mexico.

The applicants submit the following information to support their application:

1. That Mrs. Clara T. Scott and the First National Bank in Dallas, Trustee under the Will of Paul P. Scott, own all of the working interest in the subject Daniel Vaughn B-3 Lease, which is described as the N/2 of Section 3, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico, containing 320 acres, more or less.
2. That the Daniel Vaughn B-3 #1 well is located 1980 feet from the West Line and 1980 feet from the North Line of the said Section 3. That the subject well originally produced oil from the Seven Rivers zone, but has recently been plugged back and recompleted in the Yates Sand zone as a dry gas well with an open Flow Potential of 2,650 MCFPD.
