NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in Eugene Coates
Well No. 1 in S $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 3, T. 24S, R. 36E,
N. M. P. M., Cooper Oil Field Lea County,
on August 9 1935 24 lb. casing was ~~XXXXXX~~ cemented in Lime
formation at a depth of 3473 feet on August 9, 1935
200 sacks of El Toro Regular cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Haliburton plug method with pressure.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 3473 feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
