DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Attempted to pull rods to repair pump but cavings had settled around pump so badly, it was necessary to strip out rods and tubing. Halliburton Company ran steel line to 3636'; TD tubing head measurement, 3659'; 23' of cavings in hole w/ 6' of cavings above producing area.

Gibbins & Heasley, Inc., cleaned out w/ 4 3/4" x 28' Midco sand pump to TD, 3659' approximately 7 1/2 bbls of sand bailed from well w/ production increase of 5bbls per day for first 3 days, after well pumped down.
