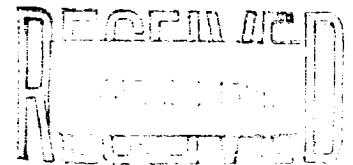

**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

Cleaned out to bottom (3639'). We found it unnecessary to shoot the well, as the production recovery was satisfactory. Due to low gas pressure, however, the well is now operating with a pumping unit. The lost time during cleaning out and installing pumping unit and equipment was 11 days, from March 9, 1939 to March 20, 1939 inclusive.
