Pulled rods and pumped hole full of mud laden fluid using 60 sax bentonitic mud. Placed 15 sack cement plug at approximately 3500'. Pulled tubing and knocked off 5½" pipe at 3030'. Pulled casing. Run tubing to 3000'. Placed cement plugs at 3000', at 1500' and at 225' as pulled tubing from hole. Set marker in concrete at surface.
