Cemented bottom (3640' w/ 25 sacks thru tubing - Shot off & recovered 2900' of 7" casing - Left in hole 635' - Spotted 10 sacks of cement @ 2900' - and 10 sk. Cement plug 1400 Ft.

Shot 9 5/8" casing @ 400', 300' & 200' unable to pull - Left in hole 1442' of 9 5/8" casing - Cemented top of 9 5/8" casing in cellar with 10 sacks of common cement - installed regular 4" marker.

Keeping hole full heavy mud.
Abandonment completed March 24, 1949
