Albert Gackle, Operator respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to No-Flare Order R-553 insofar as it pertains to Gackle's Whitten No. 1 well located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, T-24-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico completed in the Jalmat pool as an oil well. In support of this application, the following facts are submitted for your consideration:

This well as initially completed by E. P. Campbell in October 1960, and operations taken over by Gackle on July 7, 1961.

The well is presently producing 3 BOPD with a gas-oil ratio of TSTM.

A letter from El Paso Natural Gas Company refusing to connect this well at the present time.

We do not contemplate any additional development within the near future.

In view of the foregoing information and in order to keep the well on production and thereby protect correlative rights, it is requested that the Oil Conservation Commission issue an exception to its No-Flare Order R-553.
