We have prepared a new form, C-110, covering our James L. Coats No. 3 well, located in Section 10, Township 24 S. Range 36 E., which is a certificate of compliance and authorization to transport oil.

We believe we have filled in this form properly, and under "Remarks" we have noted that this lease was acquired from the Humble Oil & Refining Company, et al.

We did not know that a resident corporation of the State of New Mexico would be required to file a bond, <sup>nor do</sup> we know what type bond is required. If you will please tell us first, whether or not a resident corporation does have to file bond, and, if so, furnish <sup>us</sup> with a copy of the regulation setting out the type of bond required, we will immediately furnish such bond to the proper authorities.
