Dear Mr. Welch:

I received your letter of February 28, 1949, in regard to the J. L. Coats Lease formerly operated by the Texmass Petroleum Corporation. Your request for an allowable of 45 barrels per day has been complied with and the pipe line taking this oil notified of the increase in allowable.

My files reflect, however, that the Oil Commission has not been advised of this change of operator nor has a required bond been filed with the Commission.

I am enclosing a One-Well Bond Form 39-B1 to be executed and filed with the Oil Conservation Commission, Box 871, Santa Fe, New Mexico and a Form C-110, Authorization to Transport Oil, to be filed with the Oil Conservation Commission, Box 1545, Hobbs, New Mexico. This form C-110 should designate the change of ownership.
