NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in J.L. Coates

Well No. 1 in NE 1/4 of Sec. 10, T. 24s, R. 36e,

N. M. P. M., Cooper Oil Field Lea County,

on 8/13/35 19 9-5/8" lb. casing was { ~~XXXXXX~~ cemented } in Anhydrite formation at a depth of 5143' feet on 8/13/35 19

900 sacks of Incor Oil Well Cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Halliburton two-stage cementing device was used to cement casing, set at 1400'. 550-sacks of cement was used below and device, and 320 sacks cement above

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
