NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in J.L. Coates
Well No. 1 in NE 1/4 of Sec. 10, T. 24, R. 36,
N. M. P. M., Cooper Oil Field Lea County,
on July 30, 1935. 12 1/2 lb. casing was { burst } in Red Bed
formation at a depth of 309' feet on July 27, 1935.
With 250 sacks of Oil Well cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton Process

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of Dry feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
