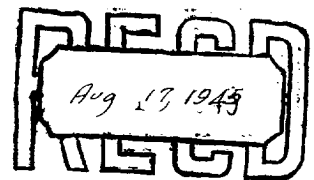

Pulled and reran Tubing with ten 5" Regular 11 1/2 Tbd. Merla 100# Differential Flow Valves as follows: 906', 1,151', 1,392', 1,637', 1,885', 2,123', 2,367', 2,605', 2,861', and 3,111'. The Tubing was set at 3,373' 9". Connected to outside gas from G. D. Woolworth #1 for gas lift.

Production before -- Well was dead.

Production after -- In 24 hours well flowed 2 barrels of oil and 3,800 barrels of water.
