I have examined the application for dual completion dated 12/14  
for Western Natural Gas Co. Toby #1-P 12-24-36  
Operator Lease Name Well No. Unit S-T-R

and my recommendations are as follows:

Disapprove-I do not feel that the open hole packer will provide complete separation between the two zones of production-my original approval of NSP application and of tests I witnessed was based upon a single zone completion and the extreme marginal nature of the lower (oil) zone of production. For the records the packer on both the Toby #1 and the Curry #1 were leaking, and should approval of this application be considered I would strongly recommend

that a complete and thorough packer leakage test be conducted prior to approval.-CR

I recommend approval feeling that a formation packer is not the best possible practice, but in this particular case that no purpose would be served by restriction to one zone or reduction of unit.-RFM

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
