Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, Western Natural Gas Company wishes to state the following:

- (a) That Western Natural Gas Company's Toby No. 1 well, located 660' from East line and 660' from South line of Section 12, Township 24-S, Range 36-E, was completed February 19, 1937 at a total depth of 3685'. The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of this well together with the location of all off-set wells.
- (b) That subject well has 7" casing set at 3256' and cemented with 100 sacks of cement. The attached Exhibit "B" is a diagrammatic sketch showing the present method of completion. This well is presently being produced as an oil well out the tubing between the two formation packers. This interval of production is 3429' - 3508'.
