

DETAILS OF WORK

The subject well produced gas through perforations 3350 to 3360, 3360 to 3364, 3367 to 3367 and 3364 to 3368 until March 1, 1947, when it was shut in due to water encroachment.

It is now proposed to plug back to approximately 3100', perforate 5 1/3" casing opposite the Yates formation as indicated by radio activity survey and recomplete as a gas well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.


