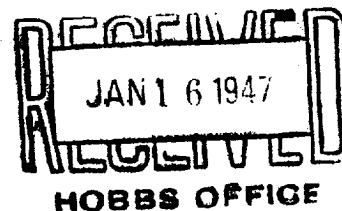

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Baker cement retainer was set at 2950 feet and the exposed formation below squeezed with 47 sacks cement. Set 5 sacks cement on top of retainer. Shot 7" casing off at 2880 feet and recovered the same. Mudded hole with 35 sacks Baroco Clay. Cemented with 15 sacks at 2840 feet. Shot 9-5/8" off at 2800 feet and recovered 1975 feet of 9-5/8". Mudded hole to near the surface and capped with 10 sacks cement. Left 275 feet of 13" casing in hole.

## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well ceased to produce oil in commercial quantities during the year of 1944. In June, 1944, the oil producing zone was plugged off and a gas section above the casing shoe was exploited. Since the gas produced is not in commercial quantity and since there is no other possible producing horizon penetrated by the well, we request the authority to plug and abandon.

We intend to place a Baker cement retainer at a depth of 2900 feet and plug off the exposed formation below with cement. The oil string will be shot off above the retainer and above the top of the cement. After the oil string has been salvaged, the hole will be filled with mud and a cement plug placed at the surface in accordance with State Regulations. The 275 feet of 13" and the 2785 feet of 9 5/8" pipe will be left in the hole.
