Dear Mr. Randolph:

Reference is made to your letter of August 27, 1957.

This letter will serve to notify you that we are this day reinstating the 270,231 MCF underage which was accumulative to this well. This will be reinstated as of July 1, 1957.

In our reclassification of wells, it was our policy not to reclassify any well as a marginal well whenever there was an objection of any nature. All operators were notified through Memorandum No. 18-57 dated May 31, 1957 and were to file objections by June 20, 1957. The above mentioned letter states that you were out of town and did not have an opportunity to object to the reclassification of your Cooper B-2. It is for this reason that we are reinstating the underage of this well with the understanding that any underage not made up by January 1, 1958, will be cancelled.

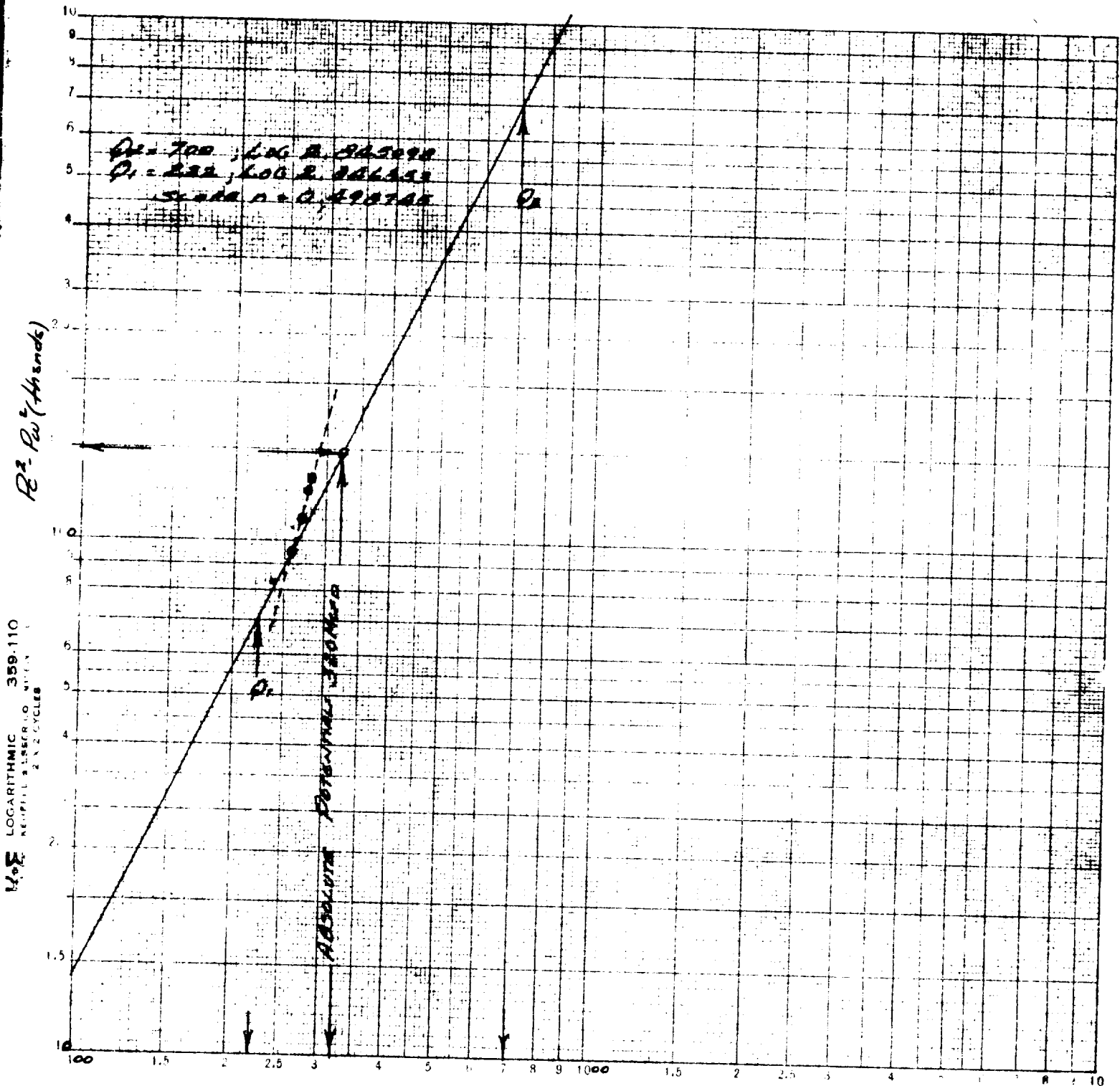
