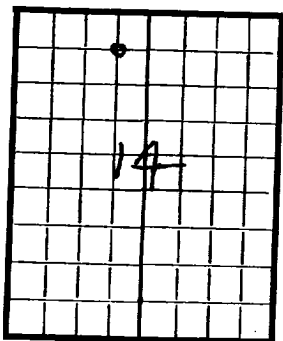

LOCATE WELL CORRECTLY

We propose to drill well with drilling equipment as follows: Rotary Tools to approximately 3600 ft. unless commercial production is found above.

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows:

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:
