Gentlemen:

Texas Pacific Oil Company, Inc., respectfully requests Administrative approval of the unorthodox location to recomplete the Cooper "B" Well No. 3 located in Unit A, 330' from the North Line and 330' from the East Line of Section 14, T-24-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This well is a TA'd Jalmat oil well and is to be recompleted as a Jalmat gas well.

The well is located within an approved 160-acre non-standard Jalmat Gas Proration Unit and simultaneous dedication is requested also. This approval is in the interest of conservation, will protect correlative rights, prevent economic waste, and will allow for more complete recovery of the Jalmat gas reserves.
