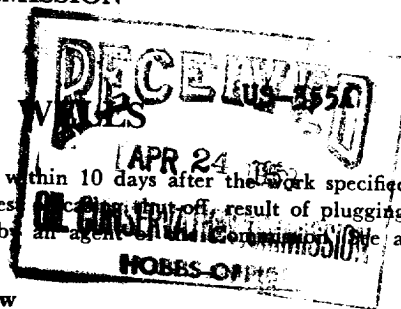

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled to a total depth of 3474'. Set 3461' of 5-1/2" 15# J-55 casing, oil string, at 3474'. Used 450 sacks cement, 200 at shoe and 250 thru 2-stage tool set at 1274'. Cement did not circulate to surface. Plug down at 5:30 P.M. 3-26-53.

Drilled cement to shoe and applied 750# pressure and held for 30 minutes. 0# pressure drop. Shut off okay at 7:30 P.M. 3-27-53.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled to a total depth of 310' and ran 297' of 8-5/8" 32# surface casing set at 305' using 200 sacks of cement. Cement did not circulate to surface. Used an additional 10 sacks of cement around casing. Plug down at 1 PM 3-12-53.

Drilled plug at 2 PM 3-13-53, applied 750# pressure and held for 30 minutes - 0# drop. Shut off okay.
