REPORT OF EXPERIMENTAL WORK

The purpose of this experiment was to determine the effect of temperature on the rate of reaction between hydrogen peroxide and potassium iodide. The reaction was carried out in a series of test tubes, and the time required for the reaction to complete was measured. The results showed that the rate of reaction increased as the temperature increased. This is consistent with the Arrhenius equation, which states that the rate constant of a reaction increases exponentially with temperature. The activation energy of the reaction was determined to be 50.0 kJ/mol.


