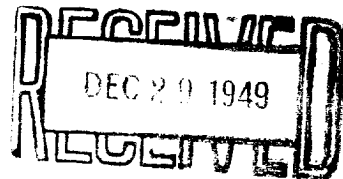

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3595' - Total Depth - Line. Ran 3-1/2" O.D. NUE Tubing to 3505' and spotted 20 sacks cement from 3250' to 3505' & flushed W/22 bbls. mud. Shot 7" OD casing at 2860' and pulled 95 Jts., 2887' of 7" OD 24-8, 10-V-Thd. S.S. Casing. Ran 3-1/2" tubing and spotted 20 sacks cement from 1553' to 1630' & plugged with 11-1/2 bbls. of mud. Shot 9-5/8" casing at 234' and recovered 8 Jts., 233'5". Ran tubing to 355', mixed 10 sacks of mud, pulled back to 265' and plugged with 125 sacks of cement - Cement circulated. Put 4" pipe, 6' high, in center of cement plug at surface. Well plugged and abandoned at 2:30 P.M., 12-20-49.

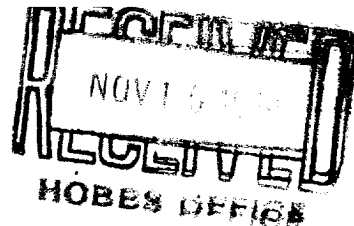

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On June 16, 1935 this well was completed at a total depth of 3595' in Line and was put to producing at a rate of 490 barrels of oil in 4 hours. Although remedial work has been performed production from this well has gradually decreased until, at this date, the well now produces approximately 2.77 barrels of oil and 600 barrels of water per day, pumping 19-34" S.P.M. We propose to plug and abandon the well.
