5-1/2 inch csg cem @ 3400' w/ 596 sx 1:1 Pozmix + 2% gel (equivalent vol 720 sx).
5-1/2" csg perf'd 3154 - 3344' (5 zones). Initial completion April 18, 1956.

Plugged well as follows:

1. Pulled tubing. Set CIBP on line @ 3100'; capped CIBP w/ 35' cement. Loaded hole with 65 barrels water.
2. Shot off 5-1/2 inch csg @ 639'; recovered 21 joints (644.32' incl. thds).
3. Ran tubing to 689'; circulated hole with 50 bbl mud. Then spotted 115 sx cement (for calculated fill 689' to 349' based on 7-7/8 inch hole).
4. Set 10 sx cement plug in top of 8-5/8 inch csg w/ regulation pipe marker.
5. Well plugged and abandoned November 26, 1974.
6. Cleaned and leveled location. Same ready for inspection.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations.
