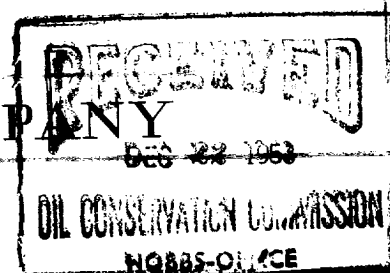

Gentlemen:

A gas plat for our S. R. Cooper #1 located in the Jalco pool was submitted to you October 27, 1953, showing an unorthodox unit. This unorthodox unit included the south half of the NE quarter and the north half of the SE quarter of section 23, T 24S, R 36E. On November 17, 1953 we received notice from you that an 80 acre allowable will be assigned the well under the new gas proration law until rule 7 of the Commission order R-368A is complied with.

After due consideration it has been decided to apply for an allowable based on the acreage outlined in red on the attached gas plat. This acreage, which is the NE quarter of section 23, T 24S, R 36E, will compose an orthodox unit and not require a hearing.

It is requested the gas plat submitted October 27, 1953 be destroyed and an allowable be assigned on the basis of the gas plat attached which is a legal quarter section.
