DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Swabbed off bottom 2 hours, recovered 24 bbls. water flush, no returns on acid. Well produced small amount gas daily, no production fluid. Pulled tubing & plugged back to 3332' by dumping 3 sacks cement into hole with dump bailer. Gun perforated 7" casing with 20 shots from 3320' to 3329' 6". Reran tubing & set at 3327' 6" with packer set 3315' 2". Acidized with 250 gal. Dowell "X". Flushed tubing with 35 bbls. water. Let set 3 hrs. Swabbed 2 hrs., recovered 20 bbls. water, no oil & swabbed tubing dry. Well vented approximately 75 MCF gas daily thru separator. Well was shut in temporarily awaiting outcome of remedial work at C. D. Woolworth #4.
