DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 3332. Ran 2" tubing to bottom & loaded hole with heavy mud. Ran 20 sacks cement from 3332-2994'. Shot 7" casing at 2700 & 2625'. Recovered 87 Jts 2661'(overall) 7" casing. Filled hole with heavy mud 2994 - 1390'. Ran 35 sacks cement 1390-1260'. Shot 9 5/8" casing at 800-700-650-600-500-400'. Recovered 13 Jts. 408'1"(overall) 9 5/8" casing. Filled hole with 100 sacks native clay to bottom of cellar. Cemented with 10 sacks cement to top of surface. Set pipe marker & abandoned location. No attempt was made to recover 12 1/2" surface pipe as 300 sacks cement was circulated around same.
