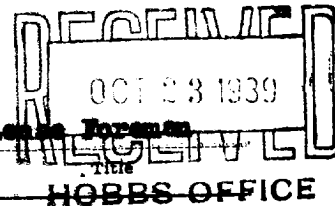
DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 3332 Line. Loaded annular space with 116 bbls. water & introduced 250 gal. Dowell "X" thru tubing. Flushed tubing with 35 bbls. water. Let well set 3 hours. Swabbed two hours, recovered approximately 20 bbls. water, no oil and swabbed tubing dry to 3300'. The well was then shut down pending decision as to future operations.
