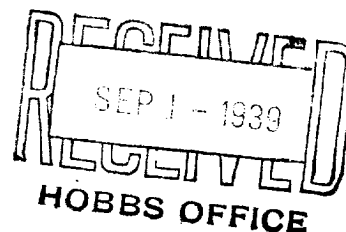

bioinformatic tools (17,18). In a recent study, we used a bioinformatic approach to identify the genes that are differentially expressed in the placenta of women with preeclampsia (19). We found that the expression of the *CD44* gene was downregulated in the placenta of women with preeclampsia. The *CD44* gene encodes a cell surface receptor that is involved in cell-cell and cell-matrix interactions (20). It is expressed in a variety of cell types, including endothelial cells, epithelial cells, and immune cells (21). The *CD44* gene has been implicated in a variety of diseases, including cancer, arthritis, and Alzheimer's disease (22,23). In the context of preeclampsia, the *CD44* gene has been shown to be downregulated in the placenta (24) and in the endothelial cells of the placental vasculature (25). This downregulation is associated with increased endothelial dysfunction and increased risk of preeclampsia (26). In the present study, we found that the expression of the *CD44* gene was downregulated in the placenta of women with preeclampsia. This finding is consistent with the results of previous studies (24,25) and suggests that the *CD44* gene may play a role in the pathogenesis of preeclampsia.
