



DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 3357. Plugged back 3416 to 3357 by setting Model "F" Baker Cement Retainer at 3357 and cemented with 100 sacks Starcor cement. Ran tubing and set packer at 3324'10". Packer failed to hold. Treated with 1000 Gallons Dowell "X" acid thru perforations in 7" casing. After swabbing out water load, well started flowing natural producing 11 bbls. of oil and 1069 bbls. of water daily. Gas/fluid ratio 1162.
