Conservation Commission, State of New Mexico, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

As we have outlined in our letter of October 14 to Mr. C. G. Staley, Hobbs, New Mexico, and reply from Mr. F. J. Vesley, relating to proposed gun perforating of certain wells in the Cooper area, Lea County, New Mexico, we wish to start this program of perforating into the gas zone of our Weelworth Well #5 located in SW SW MW Sec. S5-TR4S-R56# to supply gas for producing allowable oil by natural flow.

The easing in this well is set far into the main gas some and due to rising water level, our gas in this well is practically shut off. This well was completed September 1st, 1955, and en test produced 510 barrels of oil in 55 minutes. The gas-eil ration at this time was 257. The total depth is 5512. The easing record on this well is as follows:

12 1/2" comented at 508' 5"
9 5/8" set and comented at 1590' 1"
7" set and comented at 5468' 2"

Our proposed plan of perforation is to set a bridge at approximately the bettem of the easing but into the easing and starting at approximately \$500° with single shot perforations going down progressively until we have measured sufficient volume of gas for lifting of the fluid at efficient gas-oil ratio.

As the general outline of this program has been submitted to Mr. Staley and approved by Mr. Vesley, States Oil and Gas Inspector, we trust that this will meet with your approval and as we are in immediate need for this gas for lifting our allewable in this well, we would appreciate an early consideration.
