DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 3244 Lime. With packer set at 3195' loaded annular space above packer with water and introduced 5 bbls. oil and 500 gal. Dowell "XF-6" thru tubing while bleeding 20.5 bbls. water off casing to spot acid at 3195' to 3205'. Flushed tubing with 20 bbls. water. Unloaded hole with gas lift and tested at 2 hour intervals. No shows oil or gas. Recovered approximately 1 bbl. water & acid at each interval. Well was then shut in temporarily awaiting decision as to future operations.
