forations) and swabbed tubing dry. Acidized w/ 1500 gal. Dowell "XF-6". Swabbed tubing dry. Nothing was coming in. Pulled tubing and gun perforated 7" casing w/ 20 shots at 2-1/2' intervals from 3150' to 3197-1/2'. Run tubing with packer set 3195' w/ 8' perforations above packer. Acidized with 500 gal. Dowell "XF-6". Unloaded hole with gas lift and tested at 2 hour intervals. No shows oil or gas. Recovered approximately 1 bbl. water and acid each interval. Well was then shut in temporarily awaiting decision as to future operations.
