DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 3244 Lime. Loaded hole with water & introduced 1 bbl. oil & 500 gallons Dowell "XF-6" followed by 1 bbl. oil. Bled 19 bbls. water off casing while introducing acid thru tubing. Flushed tubing with 20.5 bbls. water. Unloaded hole with input gas and tested at four-hour intervals. Hole dry, no recovery of fluid. Slight trace of gas. Well was shut in to prepare for another acid treatment with 250 gal. acid.
