DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 3312' Lime. Set Guiberson packer at 3299' and treated well with 1000 gal. Dowell XX from 3299' to total depth. Flushed tubing with 19 bbls. water. Let acid set 2 hours & swabbed to 1200' 12 times & well started flowing. Flowed average 38 bbls. sulphur water, no oil per hour for 14 hours. During several tests this well flowed from 31-1/2 bbls. water, no oil hourly to 45 bbls. water, no oil hourly. It is intended to set a cement retainer in this well in the near future to plug off this water & place well on production.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 3350 Lime. Treated well with 1000 gal. Dowell XX. Flushed tubing with 22 bbls. water. Let acid set 2 hours and swabbed 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ hours into pits. Recovered approximately 85 bbls. water & acid, no oil. Well was then tested on gas lift. Throughout several tests well flowed from 30 to 38 bbls. water hourly, no oil.

It was then decided to raise packer and test further to determine water horizon before plugging well back.
