11/26/76 Rigged up. Rigged up reverse unit, killed well, and tried to release packer. Wouldn't come. Pulled 30,000#. Rigged down to reset sills under derrick legs. Rigged up. Pulled and laid down Guiberson packer - 2 out of 4 belly springs missing. Picked up Baker mill and ran on 1000' of 2-7/8" work string. Shut down for night at 5:30 P.M.

11/27/76 Ran remainder of work string (total 2188'). Picked up 2-7/8" tubing out of derrick to make up remainder of work string. Ran mill to 3217' (B.P. at 3273' = 56' of fill). Cleaned out 7' of FeS scale fill. Mill apparently rotating on belly springs left in hole. Clean out going very slowly. Pulled out of hole with tubing. SDFN at 5:30 P.M.

11/28/76 Attempted to thaw out air lines on rig for 3 hours with no success. Added glycol to air system. Shut down for remainder of day.

11/29/76 Fished 2 - 4" pieces of spring. Ran mill on 6 - 3-1/2" drill collars, 26# per foot to top of fill. Cleaned out down to top of bridge plug at 3273'. Milling on bridge plug. SDFN at 5:30 P.M.

11/30/76 Thawed out rig and flow line. Tried to get circulation. Broke Kelly hose, apparently frozen. Milling on bridge plug with no circulation. Water started coming back through tubing; apparently pressure below bridge plug kicking back. (Continued on attachment.)
