FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

This well was drilled to 3349' in Anhydrite & Dolomite. Three drill stem tests were run as follows: (1) 3170-3223'; (2) 3219'-3319'; (3) 3319'-3349'. There was no evidence of commercial productivity. The well was cased from 3165'-3223'; 3223'-3264'; 3264'-3319'; 3319'-3349'. The results of coring were not indicative of commercial production. Logs were run. It is proposed to plug to abandon as follows: (1) load hole with mud and luted fluid; (2) set 10 inch cement plug from 3319'-3150 (199') (3) spot 20 sack plug from 1575'-400' (100'); (4) spot 15 sack plug in top of casing with a 4"-4" pipe marker installed. It is proposed to clean location of all debris, fill pits and leave location in good condition.

The well was cored from 3165-3223'; 3223-3264'; 3264-3319'; 3319-3349'. The results of coring were not indicative of commercial production. Logs were run. It is proposed to plug to abandon as follows: (1) load hole with mud laden fluid; (2) spot 60 sack cement plug from 3349-3150 (199') (3) spot 20 sack plug from 1575'-1515' (60'); (4) spot 15 sack plug in top of casing-with a 4"-4' pipe marker installed. It is proposed to clean location of all debris, fill pits and leave location in good condition.
