**FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK**

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

The production from this well has declined to approximately  $1\frac{1}{2}$  Bbls. oil per day pumping. Due to the depth (6600') from which this well is pumped it is no longer considered a commercial well. This well will be plugged in the following manner:

Will run cement plug of 25 sacks 6620' to 6396' ( $5\frac{1}{2}$ " casing set at 6440'). Will fill hole with heavy mud laden fluid from 6396' to 4800' then run cement plug of 15 sacks of cement 4800' to 4674, shoot off  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " casing at approximately 4500' and pull same. Fill hole with heavy mud laden fluid to 3600' and run cement plug of 54 sacks of cement to 3400', heavy mud laden fluid to 2750', run cement plug of 10 sacks of cement 2750' to 2720' ( $8\text{--}5/8$ " casing set 2790' and cemented w/ 1000 sacks), heavy mud laden fluid to 20'. Install cement cap from 20' to surface and install 4" pipe marker.
