NOTICE OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE NEW YORK STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION, CONCERNING THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF A DAM AND THE DESTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE, IN THE TOWN OF ALBANY, COUNTY OF ALBANY.

IN SENATE, JANUARY 1, 1904.

THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE NEW YORK STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION, in pursuance of the provisions of the CONSERVATION LAW, chapter 108 of the Laws of 1902, and chapter 108 of the Laws of 1903, and chapter 108 of the Laws of 1904, do hereby give notice that they have received from the ALBANY WATER SUPPLY COMMISSION, a petition for the construction of a dam and the destruction of a bridge, in the town of Albany, county of Albany.

The petition of the ALBANY WATER SUPPLY COMMISSION, is in substance as follows: That the ALBANY WATER SUPPLY COMMISSION, for the purpose of supplying water to the city of Albany, desires to construct a dam across the river, and to destroy the bridge which crosses the river at the place where the dam is to be constructed. The ALBANY WATER SUPPLY COMMISSION, further desires to acquire the land which is necessary for the construction of the dam and the destruction of the bridge.

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
