Additional information: **In cementing the 16" OD casing the cement will be circulated back to bottom of cellar. The 13", 10-3/4" and 8-5/8" OD casing will be pulled at the time the 7" casing is run & cemented. In cementing the casing Halliburton Process will be used.**
